

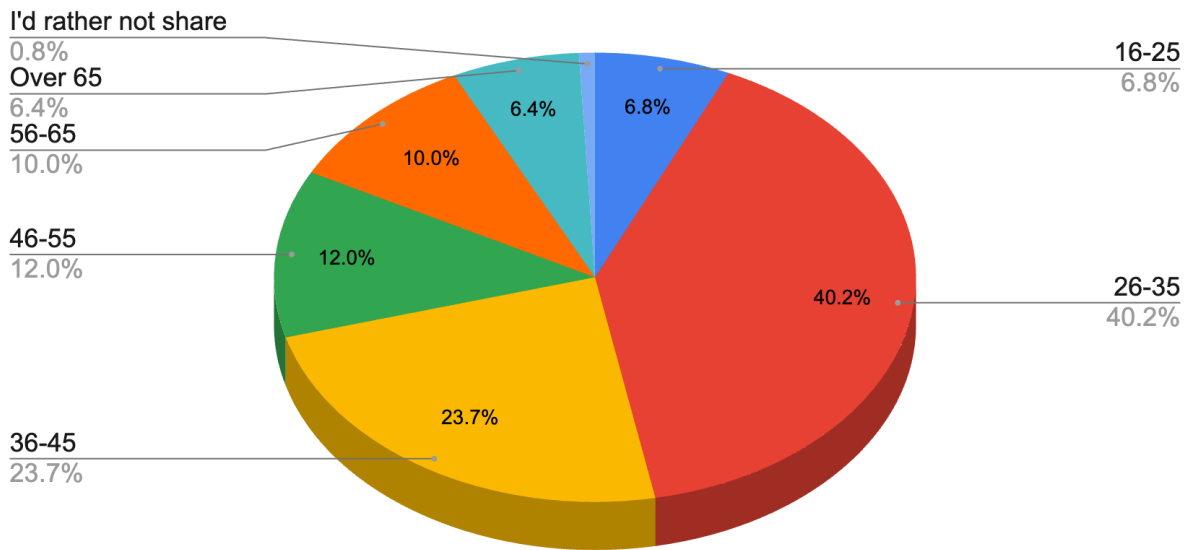

Survey Description:

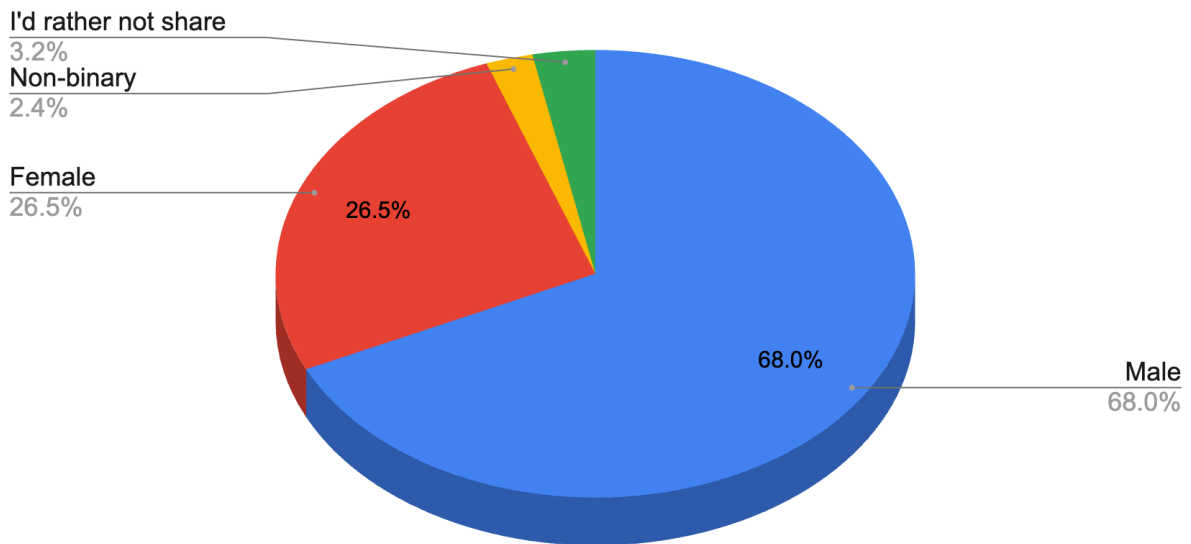

The SLCA administered a community survey from January 8, 2024, to February 13, 2024, receiving **249 responses**. Presented below is a broad overview of the summary findings.

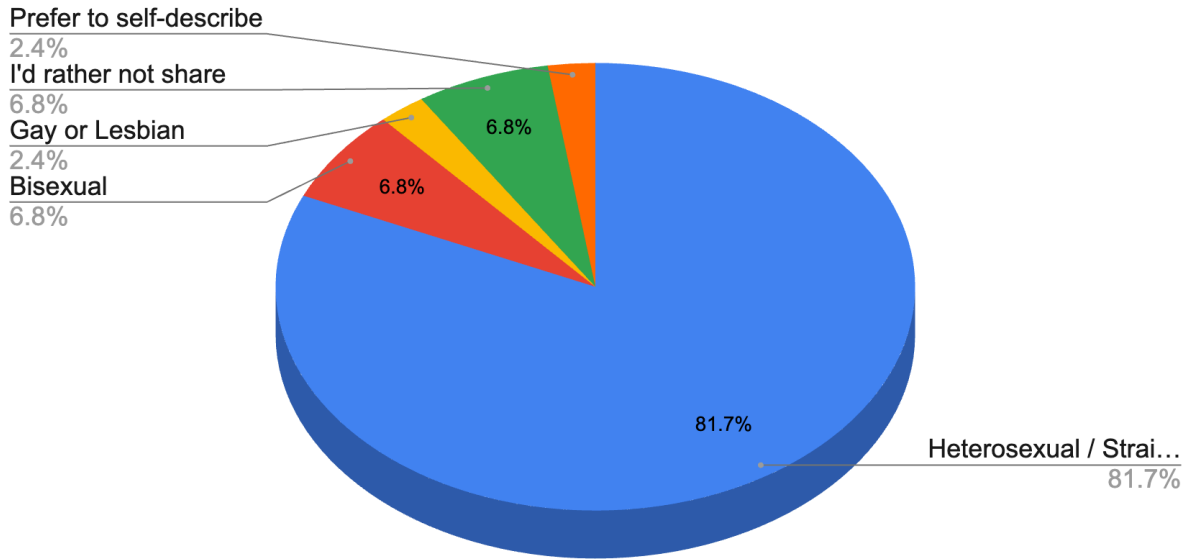
Age



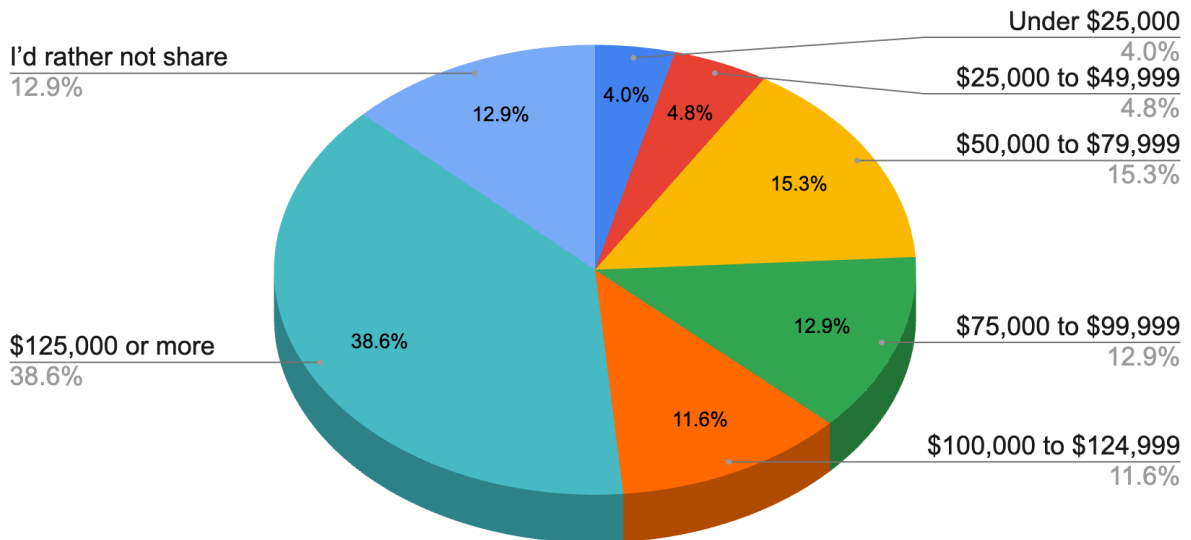
With which gender do you most identify?



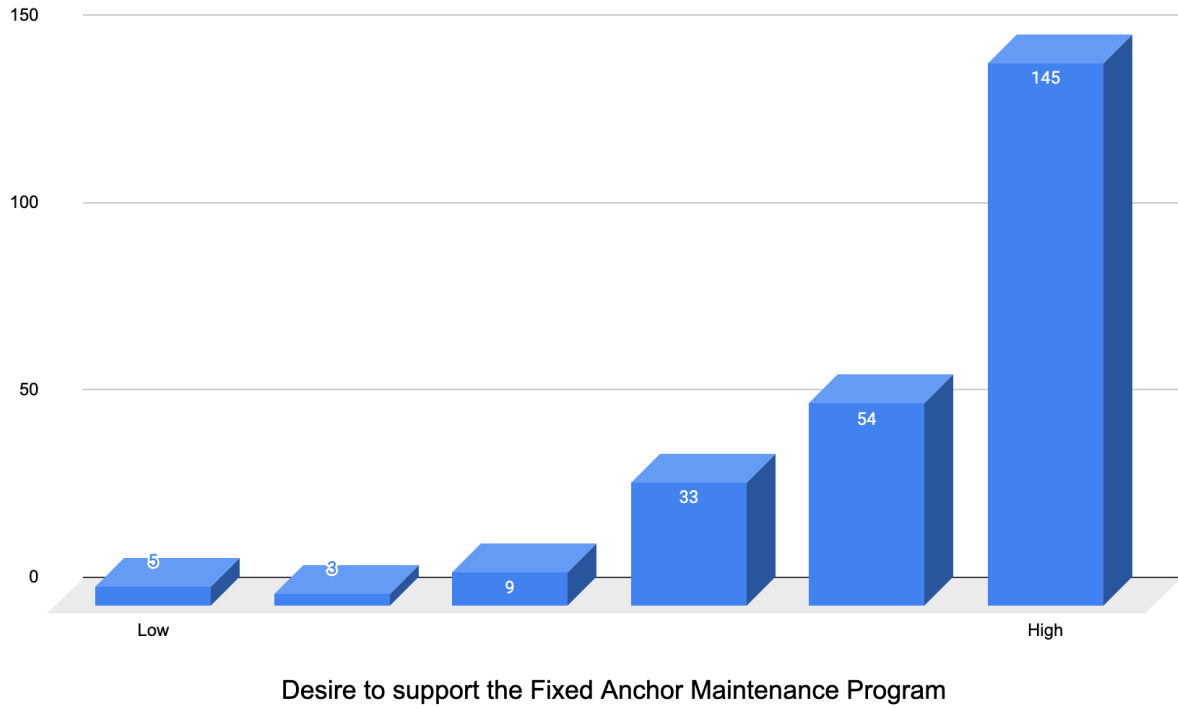
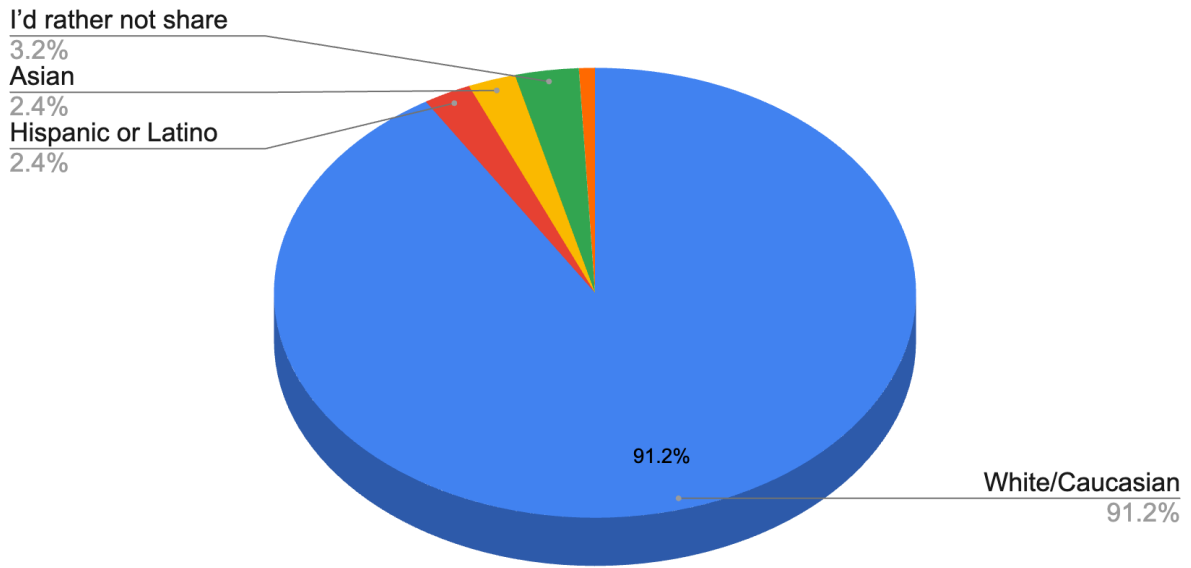
Sexual Orientation

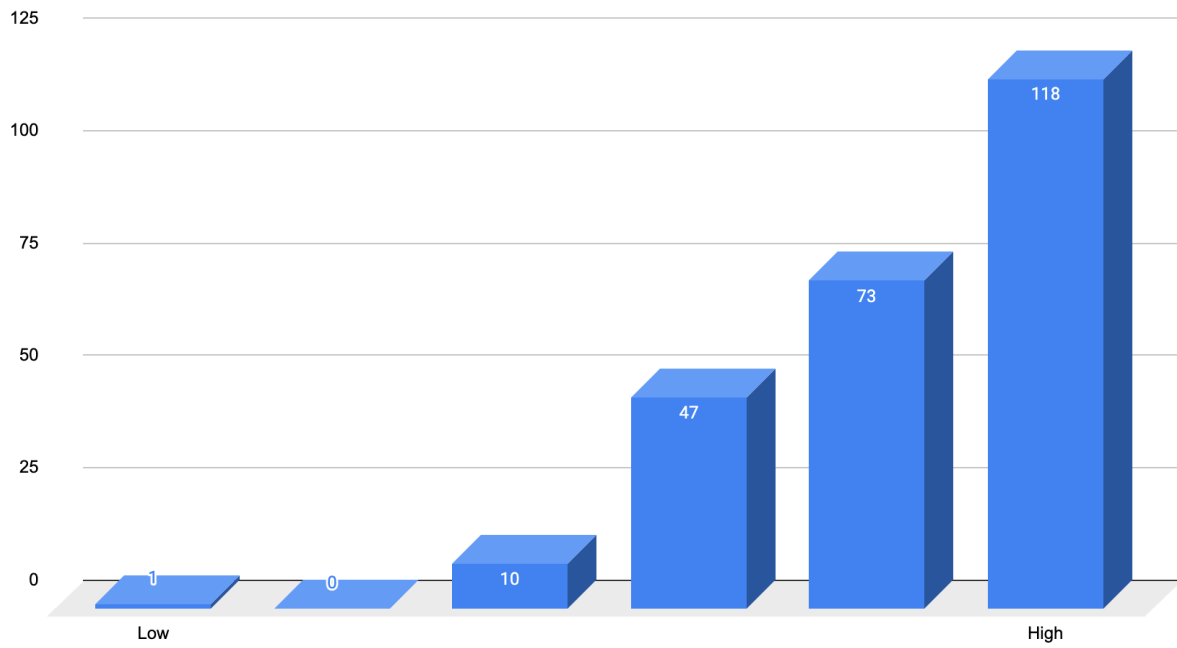


Household Income

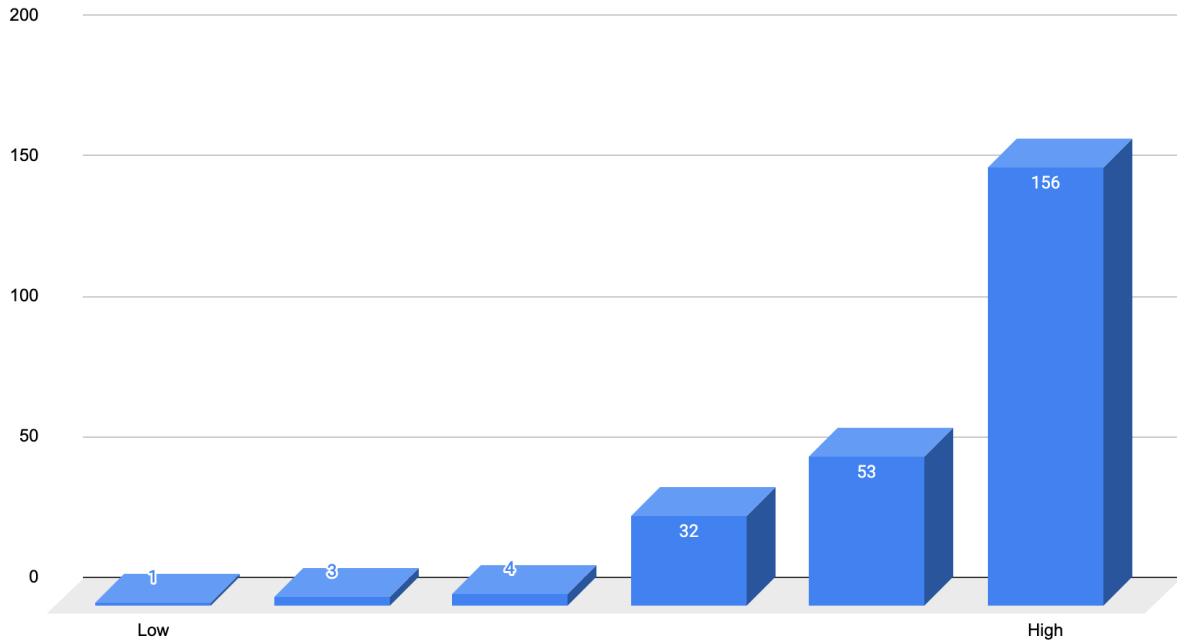


Race / Ethnicity

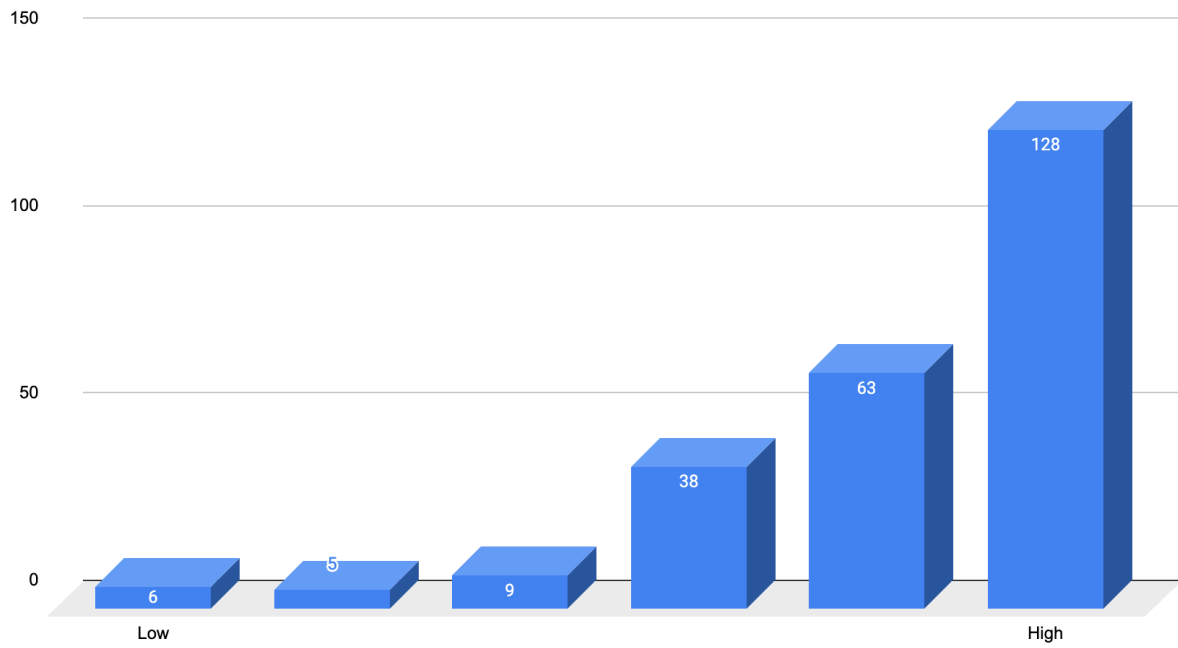




Desire to support the SLCA stewardship efforts

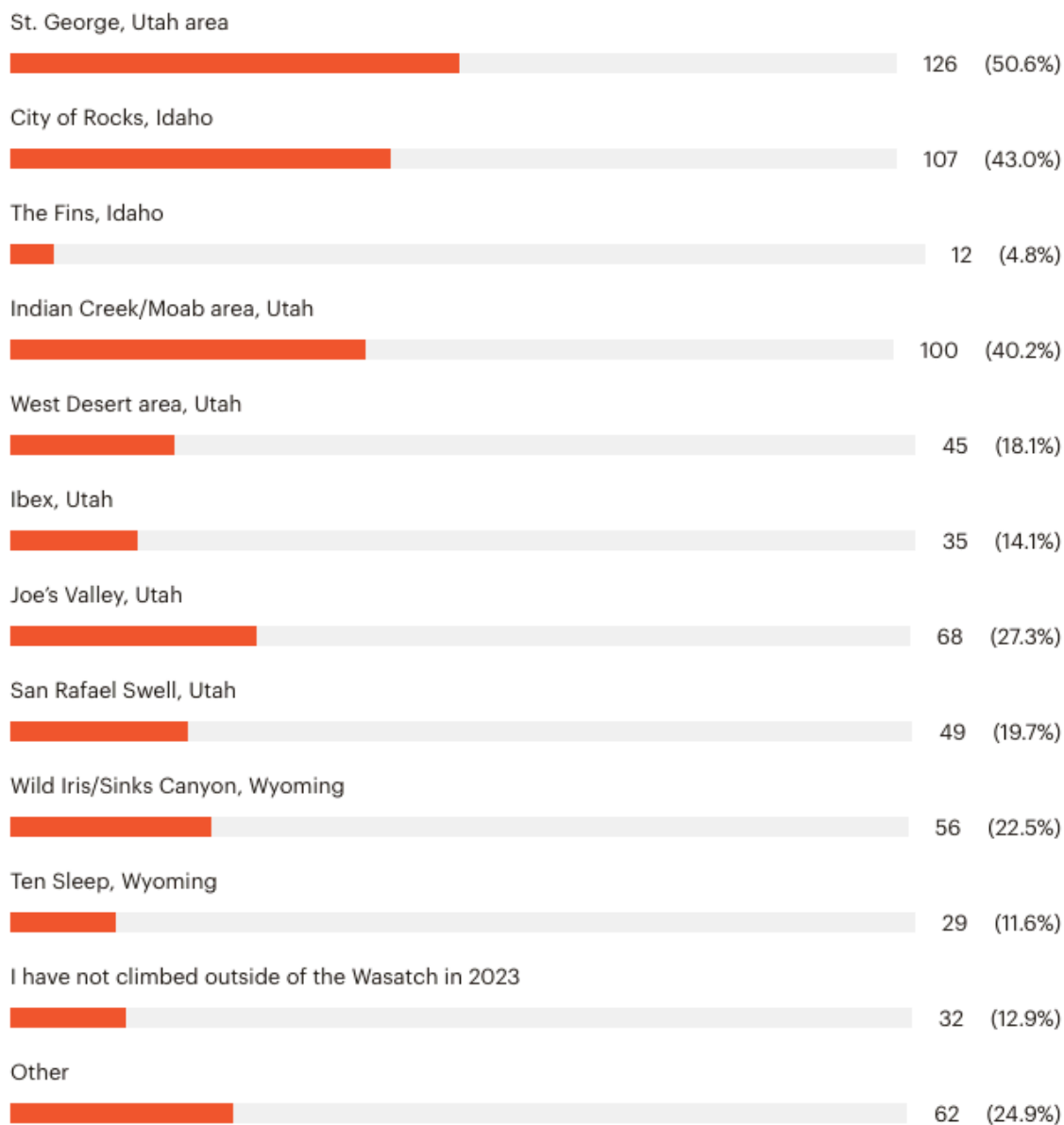


Concern over climbing access threats

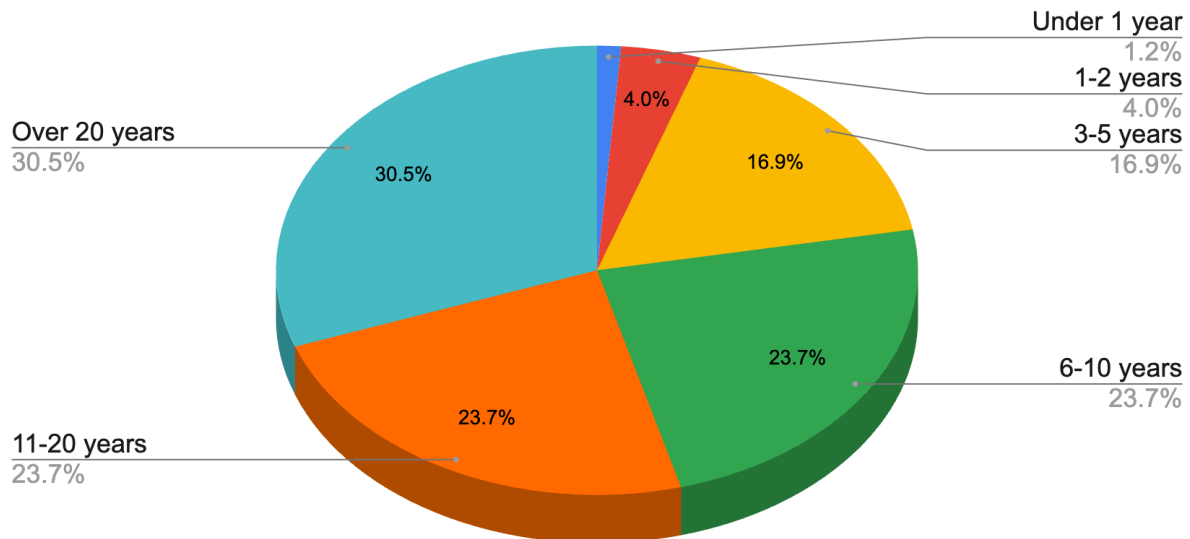


Concerns over the environmental impact of climbers on natural areas
